1. FULLY INFLATABLE WALLS?

Kids cannot bounce off netted walls as their hands, feet, and even teeth can get caught in netting. The castle will also tip over if children bounce on them.

2. IS IT UV PROTECTED?

A UV shade cover protects your kids from exposure to the sun!

3. RAIN COVER?
